Bailu, or White Dew, is the 51 (fifteen) of the twenty-four solar terms(节气). It falls 52 Sept 8 this year. In White Dew season, the weather turns cooler and plants begin to wither(枯萎). During this time, some birds like swallows(燕子) head south, while other birds start preparing 53 (store) food for the winter.
